Hello preschool families!

This week, we will conclude our unit on Feelings/Emotions. We will be learning about names of different feelings, identifying feelings, describing feelings, and how to work through big feelings. We will continue to learn calm down strategies throughout the school year. As we learn new skills, I will be updating the "Calm Down Strategies" section on our classroom website. You can help by practicing some of the skills at home. You can also practice identifying and describing feelings together. One way you could do this is by talking about characters' feelings in stories you read together.

During Bible Time, we will be learning about Jesus' birth and will also be rehearsing our Christmas pageant. The preschool Christmas program (3-day & 5-day classes) will be on the evening of December 15th before the church Advent service. Families are also invited to stay for the Advent service following the program. There are not any corresponding newsletters for Bible Time because most of the time will be spent preparing for the Christmas program. You can still help at home by reviewing this story with your child. You could also try acting it out, drawing pictures of some of your favorite parts of the story, or using puppets to retell the story.

We will try to get to skills and fancy words this week, but may not get to them depending on how the day goes with our Christmas program rehearsals.
